Coaches and Managers Responsibilities

- ❖ This is a volunteer position
- ❖ Coaches and managers are expected to attend a coach/manager meeting if one is scheduled (date TBA) prior to the provincial final event as well as their regional team's Pep Rally (date TBA).
- ❖ Coaches and managers will be responsible for the sale of Opening and Closing Ceremony Tickets. Parents, family members and fans alike are welcome to attend.
- ❖ Coaches and managers are expected to supervise and be responsible for the conduct of their athletes at ALL times during the provincial finals. This includes en route to and from the host community, during competition and during free time.
- ❖ All Coaches/Managers are required to remain in the host community for the full duration of their phase of the Games, including Opening and/or Closing Ceremonies.
- ❖ All participants under 18 years of age are required to stay in the athletes' village and they must always be properly chaperoned by their coach/manager who must also stay in the athletes' village. The host committee will designate a "curfew" hour, which must be adhered to by ALL residents of the athlete's village.
- ❖ Ensure that the Manitoba Games rules are adhered to:
 - No alcohol, smoking or banned substances in the Athlete Village or Sport Venues
- ❖ Work closely with Sport Manitoba, the Manitoba Games Council and Mission Staff to ensure maximum safety and fun during the games.
- ❖ Direct any problems, concerns and questions to the regional team Mission Staff.
- ❖ All members of the regional team are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will serve as an example to others. Remember at all times that you are an ambassador for your region and sport and that you should act with personal dignity, integrity and within the spirit of good sportsmanship and fair play at all times both in and out of competition.
- ❖ To act as a cheerleader and supporter for all regional team members
